NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior Handler awards with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am on Saturday & Sunday, June 23 & 24, 2018. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday.

GENERAL INFORMATION & SHOW RULES

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR, WHO MUST EXERCISE CONTROL & RESTRAINT OVER THE CHILD WHILE THE CHILD IS ON THE SHOW PREMISES. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN ACTION BY THE SHOW COMMITTEES.

EXHIBITORS MUST BE GOVERNED BY ANY RULES OR REGULATIONS OF THE CIVIL AUTHORITIES OR BUILDING AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS. Exhibiting & parking at this show is a privilege extended by the Alaska Kennel Club, Inc. & Service High School. Any exhibitor, handler, driver or vehicle occupant who feels that they cannot abide by the rules & regulations or resorts to abusive language and/or other tactics & who argues with parking personnel or show officials in an attempt to circumvent the rules & regulations will be turned away & forfeit privileges without refund.

THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING NOR INTENSIVE OR CORRECTIVE TRAINING OF DOGS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR PREMISES. THE USE OF CORRECTIVE DEVICES IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE A DOG from a parked car on the show grounds, the Clubs will not be responsible or liable for any damages to the car involved.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION FOR SERVICE HIGH SCHOOL

- 1 An Exercise area will be available. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up the area after their dog has used it.
- 2 FOOD CONCESSION will be available.
- 3 A fee of \$5.00 will be charged for day parking.
- 4 Limited Reserved RV & Tent Camping parking & Reserved Grooming tent areas will be available on the grounds.
- 5 **There will be no pounding of stakes, nails or any other object into the asphalt. Anyone found doing so will be subject to action taken by the show committee.**
- 6 No Alcoholic Beverages or Non-Prescription Drug use allowed on ASD property.

SPACE FOR UNENTERED DOGS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED AT THESE SHOWS.

MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITY

The management will exercise every precaution for the safety of the dogs exhibited, & it is understood that neither the clubs nor the management nor the landlord will be responsible for the loss of, damage to or any damage caused by any dog from any cause.

EXHIBITORS & HANDLERS are required to keep their dogs under control at all times, restrained & kept away from ALL shrubbery, flowers & lawns except in designated areas.

THE CLUBS may decline any entries for cause & may refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show premises on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, & no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Clubs or any officials thereof for such action.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

Except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, NO DOGS wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS in any forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities or building & parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

TROPHIES

Other than Best in Show & Groups, trophies will **NOT** be presented in the ring. Exhibitors will receive cards in the ring - these cards will be exchanged for the trophy at a central location. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to claim any & all trophies prior to the conclusion of Group Judging. No trophy will be mailed. The Clubs are not responsible for lost or broken trophies after receipt. The Clubs reserve the right to substitute a trophy with one of equal or greater value if conditions make it necessary. All trophies not used or claimed at the shows become the property of the Clubs, to be used at future shows in the donor's name.

A Judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp). Ramps can be used in emergency situation to judge any breed. In an emergency situation an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Lagotto Romagnolo, American Water Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cirneco dell'Etna, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc).

The following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei and Chow Chows.

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING on Saturday. Check Judging Program for time & location.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

EXHIBITORS NOTE: Please notify Superintendent of any change of address.

FAX/EMAIL ENTRIES AND PAPER ENTRIES WITH CREDIT CARD ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE METHODS FOR ENTRIES AND WILL NOT BE PROCESSED. **Online Entries and Checks by Mail are not affected by this change.** If mailing be sure to have the entry with check enclosed arrive prior to the closing date of the show. Please note all entries received via fax or email and/or paper entries with credit card information will be shredded/deleted immediately upon delivery without processing. With credit card security and identity theft concerns we are implementing this change to protect your information from potential abuse. Entry forms are occasionally viewed by others outside of the staff of the Superintendent. We will always be happy to accept entries with payment by check at any of our shows. Stop by and say hello.

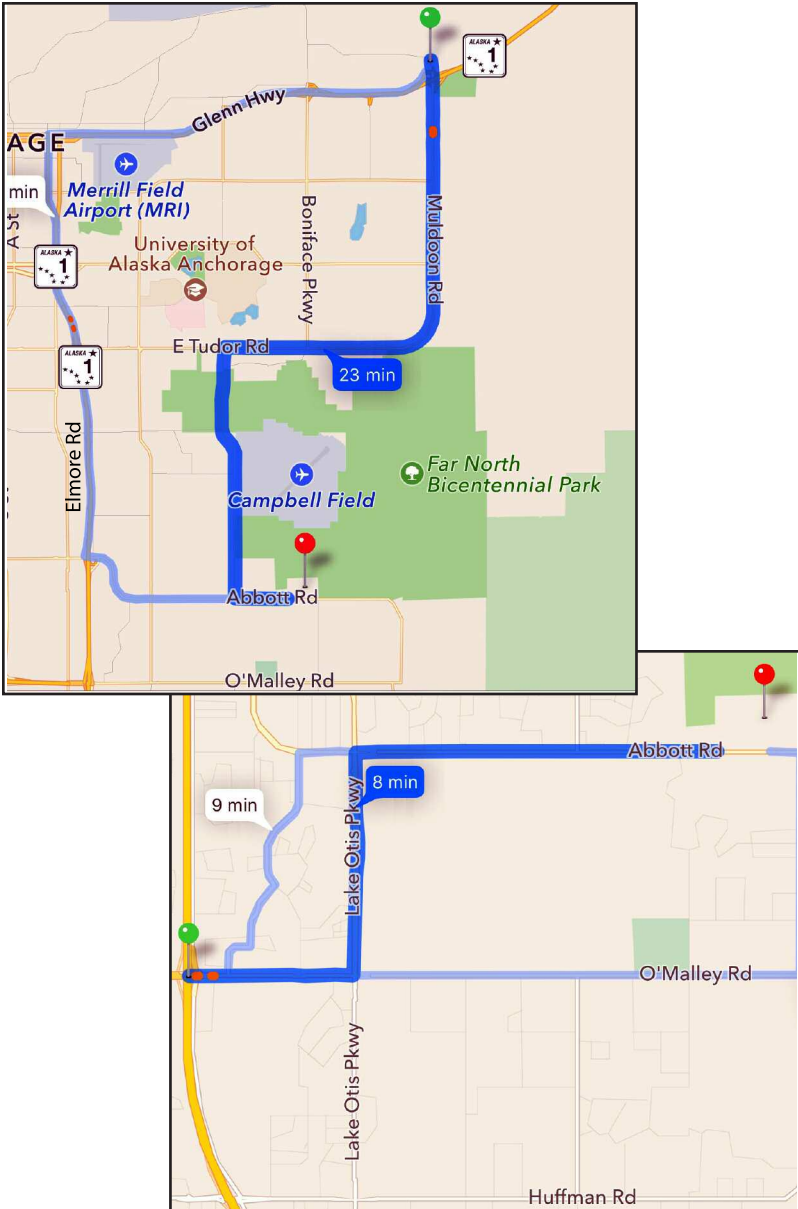

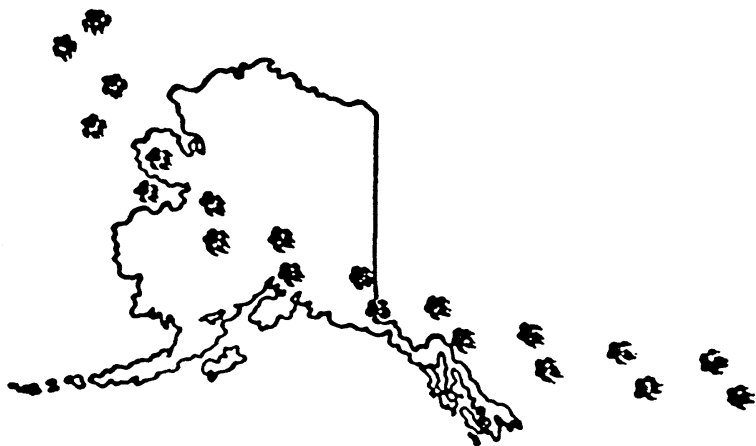

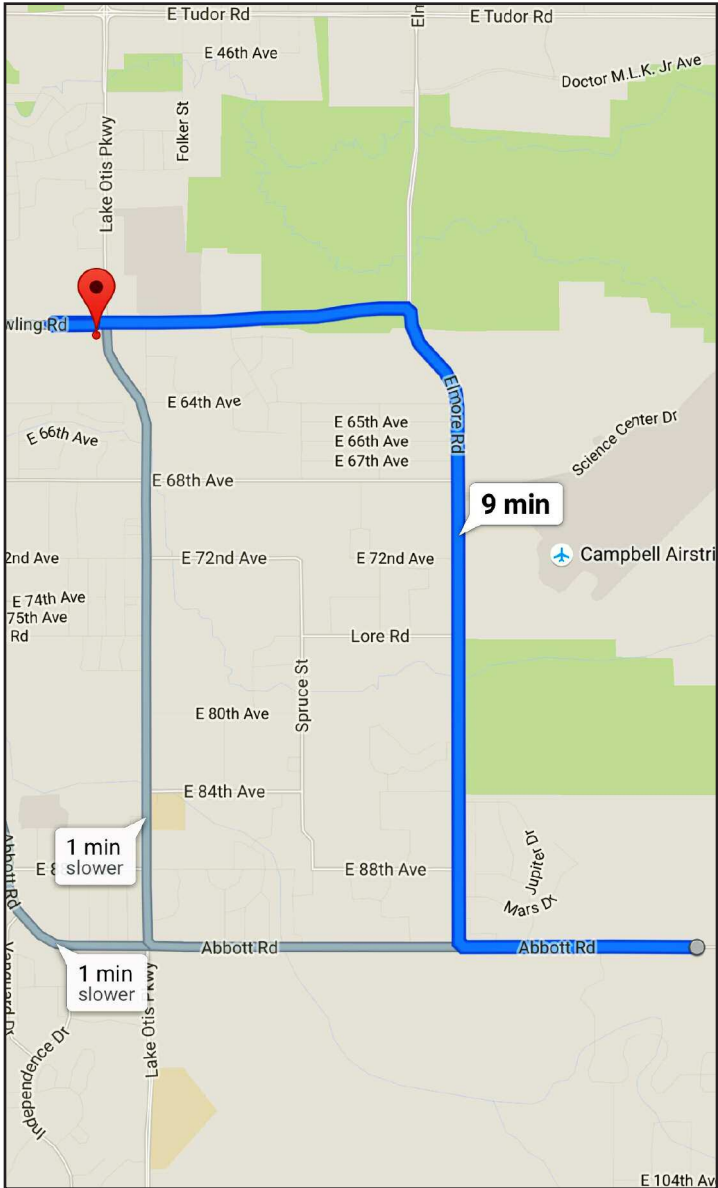
