# **COVID-19 INFORMATION**

Exhibitors, judges, volunteers, and spectators will be required to comply with all CDC, State and local mandates in place at the time of the event. Currently, the required physical distance for non-family members will be maintained. Masks covering NOSE and mouth must be worn on the trial grounds except when in your own setup/canopy or tent. No mask needs to be worn while running, but a special exit area will be in place to re-mask after your run. If the entire event must be cancelled because of COVID-19, all entry fees will be refunded. Applicable AKC guidelines will be in effect.

Eligible Dogs: These trials are open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternate Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs should be physically sound. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs, and bitches in season are ineligible to compete. No dog will participate who is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything medical attached for any purpose.

Dogs may wear a flat buckle or rolled leather collar. There shall be no attachments or tags, hanging or otherwise allowed. The dog may run without a collar. Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring, or at the practice jump.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

(Chapter 4, Section 15 of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials) The "grounds" include the entire Sirius Ranch facility, parking lots, buildings, RV/motor home parking area, etc.

There will be two rings; rings will alternate so no rings run at the same time, starting each day with ring 1. Preferred classes will run with the corresponding regular classes and height divisions. Master and Excellent classes will run together.

#### **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS**

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility to enter into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible to enter into the correct class(es) and height divisions. Dogs running in a lower or higher height division than they are eligible will be eliminated.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend

- Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title.
- The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

 Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

Note - A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO) As of January 1, 2020

This will be offered at this trial during the FAST class offered.

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered at this trial.
- FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.
- FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes.
- FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment.
- Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST.
- Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class.
- FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out.
- FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring.
  - Toys must be non-audible.
  - Toys may not leave the handler's hand.
  - Toys that roll freely cannot be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time Time is course time not max course time. Fix and Go On (FNG) As of January 1, 2020
  - FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave

the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Jump Height Cards: All dogs entered MUST be measured by the judge before their first run except those with AKC jump height cards. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running if necessary. If your dog is measured into a taller jump height class, he must be moved up into it at the trial. If your dog is measured down, he cannot be moved into a lower jump class. The dog maybe switched from regular to preferred as allowed in Chapter 1, Section 21 page 18 of the Regulations for Agility Trials and ACT handbook. The Judge of Record will NOT be measuring dogs at this trial. Currently only a Voluntary Measuring Official (VMO) may measure dogs. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request.

<u>Jump Height Card Process:</u> There is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or needs to be measured. Please mark the appropriate box, so the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the <u>Dogs to be Measured List.</u>


