COVID-19 INFORMATION:

<u>Exhibitors</u>, judges, and volunteers will be required to comply with all CDC, State/Borough and Facility mandates in place at the time of the event. Applicable AKC guidelines will be in effect.

Eligible Dogs: These trials are open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternate Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs should be physically sound. Blind, lame, or aggressive dogs, and bitches in season are ineligible to compete. No dog will participate who is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything medical attached for any purpose.

Dogs may wear a flat buckle or rolled leather collar. There shall be no attachments or tags, hanging or otherwise allowed. The dog may run without a collar. <u>Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring, at the practice jump, or the fenced exercise area</u>.

<u>Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s)</u>. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

VOLUNTEERS & SET UP

Please sign-up to work when you arrive at the trial!

It takes a lot of people to run an agility trial. The Club would appreciate your help in making sure the trial is a success and hopes that everyone will volunteer for **at least** one to two positions each day! Thank you for your help!

Show Site & Hours: 7:30 a.m. to 30 minutes after last dog runs.

Thursday: Arena will be open from 3 p.m. – 6 p.m. November 18 for set up. *Personal set-up will not begin until after all trial set-up is complete!

Friday, Saturday, & Sunday: Trial site hours are 7:30 AM to 30 minutes after the last dog runs. **Obstacles:** Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

CLASSES OFFERED AND WARM UP

<u>Standard Classes:</u> Novice A & B, Open, Excellent, Masters, Novice Preferred, Open Preferred, Excellent

Preferred, Masters Preferred, Premier, FAST

Jumpers with Weaves: Novice A & B, Open, Excellent, Masters, Novice Preferred, Open Preferred, Excellent

Preferred, Masters Preferred, Premier

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers in that class only.

A warm- up area consisting of a single regulation agility jump will be provided. "No agility obstacle training is allowed on the show grounds except for the use of the warm-up jump." (Chapter 4, Section 15 of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials) The "grounds" include the entire Sirius Ranch facility, parking lots, buildings, RV/motor home parking area, etc.

There will be one ring; **first dog on the line at 9:00 am**. Preferred classes will run with the corresponding regular classes and height divisions. Master and Excellent classes will run together and all levels of FAST will run by jump height.

Run Order:

Friday: Small to Tall

JWW - Premier, Master/Excellent Standard - Premier, Master/Excellent

NO Novice or Open Classes will be offered on Friday

Saturday: Tall to Small

FAST, Standard - Master/Excellent, Open, Novice

JWW - Master/Excellent, Open, Novice

Sunday: Small to Tall

JWW – Master/Excellent, Open, Novice Standard – Master/Excellent, Open, Novice

Classes: It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in with the gate steward and be at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The Judge is not obligated to wait for any exhibitor.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Classes: Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility to enter into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible to enter into the correct class(es) and height divisions. Dogs running in a lower or higher height division than they are eligible will be eliminated.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend

- Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or
 during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog
 qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day,
 then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title.
- The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

 Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

Note - A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO) As of January 1, 2020

- FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes.
- FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.
- FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment.
- Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST.
- Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class.
- FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare on the start line the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out.
- FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring.
 - Toys must be non-audible.
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand.
 - o Toys that roll freely cannot be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time Time is course time not max course time.

Fix and Go On (FNG) As of January 1, 2020

Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Jump Height Cards: All dogs entered MUST be measured by the judge before their first run except those with AKC jump height cards. Measuring will take place at 8:00 a.m. If your dog is measured into a taller jump height class, he must be moved up into it at the trial. If your dog is measured down, he cannot be moved into a lower jump class. The dog maybe switched from regular to preferred as allowed in Chapter 1, Section 21 page 18 of the Regulations for Agility Trials and ACT handbook.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request.

<u>Jump Height Card Process:</u> There is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or needs to be measured. Please mark the appropriate box, so the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the <u>Dogs to be Measured List.</u>

Entries not on an AKC form (that includes the disclaimer form on the back) are not acceptable. Please make sure only AKC recognized prefixes and suffixes are used on all entries.

Email confirmation will be sent to those listing a legible email address. Final entry confirmation and judging schedule will be e-mailed or sent to the entry address as soon as possible after the closing date. If you have not received confirmation at least 7 days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

<u>Move-Ups</u>: Move up to a higher class will be allowed if received by the Trial Secretary in writing by Monday, **November 15, 2021, 5:00pm AST**. No move-ups will be accepted after that date and time; E-mail is acceptable 1cikcagility@gmail.com. Move-ups for Saturday or Sunday will be allowed if received by the trial secretary in writing **within 30 minutes** of the end of judging on the previous day at the trial site. No move ups will be accepted after that time. Verbal changes will not be accepted.

Notices to Exhibitors

This trial will be held under the AKC rules and regulations for agility trials. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with these rules and regulations. **Note:** additional CDC, AKC, and local COVID-19 rules and guidelines may be in place.

Bitches in season are not allowed within Sirius Ranch boundaries.

Food: To be determined.

Indoor crating/car crating: will be determined PRIOR to trial and be announced.

<u>Trophies:</u> Ribbons for first, second, third, fourth place, qualifying scores, and new titles will be given. A choice of Double Q pin or ribbon will be awarded to dogs earning a Double Q in Masters. MACH and PACH ribbons will be awarded to those earning titles at these trials.

Refunds:

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. If we are forced to cancel due to Alaska State and/or Municipal mandates, we will refund entry fees.

<u>Bitches in season</u> are not permitted to compete in agility trials. With written notice, handlers with <u>bitches who</u> <u>come in to heat</u> after the closing date and before or during the trial, may receive a_refund.

Safety, Behavior, and Liability

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and agree to abide by them, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The Midnight Sun Golden Retriever Club, Sirius Ranch, and their agents, directors, officers, members, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Midnight Sun Golden Retriever Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Midnight Sun Golden Retriever Club, Sirius Ranch or any official thereof.
